

Maths Functional Skills

About the Course

Start Date: September 2024 **End Date:** January 2025

Course Length: 1 session of 3 hours each per week over 16 weeks plus additional online learning.

The course is in the physical environment at Hounslow House.

You will need to pass 2 exams: one calculator and one non-calculator, to achieve the Maths Functional Skills qualification at Level 1 which is accredited by Pearson Edexcel.

There is approximately 2-4 hours of homework per week.

Course Learning Outcomes

- Apply mathematical skills and knowledge to solve problems in everyday life and work.
- Calculate fractions, decimals, percentages and ratio
- Work out how to calculate quantities of length, weight, capacity, time and money, understand and apply scale
- Understand, calculate and present statistical information

Please note: To successfully complete this course you must commit to 100% attendance and punctuality.

What is needed for the course?

- You will need an initial assessment and to demonstrate that your maths skills are strong.
- Access to a laptop or tablet with internet, camera and microphone.
- You need to have English skills at Entry 3 or above.
